PA FAIR Cattle Health Requirements for Departments 2, 3, 10, 11 Revised 5-30-24

Prohibition of exhibition of dairy cattle:

Dairy cattle from a premises on which dairy animals are showing clinical signs of infection with influenza A virus are prohibited from entering an exhibition. Clinical signs may include a decrease in feed consumption, with a simultaneous decrease in rumination and rumen motility; respiratory signs including clear nasal discharge; and subsequent acute drop in milk production. Additional clinical signs may include abnormal tacky or loose feces, lethargy, dehydration, and fever. Severely affected cattle may have thicker, concentrated, colostrum-like milk or produce no milk at all. Animals showing clinical signs compatible with infection must be cleared by the State Animal Health Official.

Requirements & Recommendations:

1. Official identification is required for sexually intact cattle. Official identification includes any of the following:
 - (a) A USDA issued National Uniform Eartagging System (NUES) tag.
 - (b) A 15-digit Animal Identification Number (AIN) ear tag starting with "840"
2. A current Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) (valid for 30 days after the date of issue). A current VCPR Form may also be used to verify animal ID. In addition to the identification for sexually intact cattle, steers and spayed heifers should be identified with forms of ID consistent with # 1 in requirements above.
3. All animals must be free of evidence of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this should be written on the CVI. A current rabies vaccination administered by a licensed veterinarian for animals 3 months of age and older (observe appropriate slaughter withdrawal time).

Fair Regulations for Departments 2, 3, 10, 11

1. All animals must be provided with fresh water at all times and fed daily. Stalls must be kept clean and tack areas kept in a orderly fashion. Exhibitors must furnish their own bedding, (no newspapers).
2. Any persons mistreating any animal will be asked to leave the premises immediately and the proper authorities will be informed.
3. The Fair reserves the right to refuse any or all entries.
4. No entries will be accepted once stall space has been exhausted.
5. Entry fees are non-refundable.
6. Stall Cards and Entry Tags must be hung when animals are stalled.
7. There will be a "Stall Cleaning Fee" that will be applied to any premium winnings if the exhibitor does not clean the stalls before leaving the premises.
Stall Cleaning Fee: \$25.00
8. The Fair Board reserves the right to adjust the premiums in classes where there are only one competitor and there was NO competition.

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Fair Regulations - Day of Judging

1. Exhibitor can compete in two (2) Departments only. Department 2, open to 8 years and up. Department 3, open to 8 years and up.
Department 10, 4-H & Vocational Club Members only.
Department 11, open to youth ages 5-19 years and not in a 4-H or Vocational Club.
2. NO Cattle shall be entitled to a premium unless healthy and serviceably sound.
3. ALL Cattle entered must compete and be shown to receive any award or premium.
4. An animal may be shown ONLY by the person in whose name the animal was entered.
5. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to know the judging schedule. Animals must be in the ring promptly on call and a failure to comply with the order renders exhibitors liable to be ruled out of competition.
6. Exhibitors will be expected to display or parade their animals as directed by the Superintendent and Judge.
7. Animals must be shown individually before entering group classes.
8. An animal in a Class will not be able to win more than one (1) place.
9. All animals in a Class will be judged together.
10. In cases where there is NO competition, the Fair Board reserves the right to adjust the premiums in a class where there is only one (1) competitor.
11. The adopted Code of Show Ring Ethics will be enforced.

Entry Forms Departments 2, 3, 10, 11

1. 4-H & Vocational must use the Department number 10 and may enter in open class Department 2 or 3.
2. Youth 19 and under must use the Department number 11 and may enter in open class Department 2 or 3.
3. Please print your club's name, school name, and your age.
4. Department 2 & 3 - Ages 8 years and over
5. Department 10 - 4-H/Vocational Club Members Only, Ages 8-18.
6. Department 11 - Youth Under 19 years of age

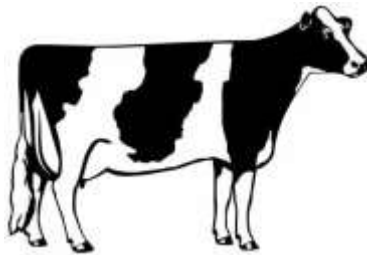
