Must have 2 or more competitors in each class to be considered competitive.

NO ENTRY FEE

Exhibitor must be enrolled in an appropriate 4-H Club or FFA Chapter.

1. In selecting vegetables for exhibition, choose specimens that would bring the highest market price. Do not select the largest; select medium size specimens. If at all possible, do not mix varieties.
2. The following factors are generally used by an expert vegetable judge.
 - Trueness to variety type.
 - Uniformity in shape, size and color.
 - Pick out the perfect specimen, then select the others as similar to it as possible.
 - Protect from dirt, disease, infection or mechanical damage. Select specimens that are perfect and show no blemishes of any kind.
 - Condition and maturity.
 - Potatoes should NOT be washed. Remove soil using a soft cloth.
 - Tomatoes should have stems removed. Carrots, beets, etc. should have tops (leaves) removed to leave 2 inches of stem.
3. All produce will become the property of the Fair Association. After judging and before fair's end, any rotten vegetables will be disposed of.
