\$20.00 ALL Track Gate Entry, includes Pits.

All persons ENTERING the TRACK GATE must sign a release form and receive an armband.

Entry Fee: \$0.00 at registration.

All Classes are double elimination.

Must have 2 or more entries to make a class.

Classes:

1. Diesel Trucks: 4-wheel drive, automatic and standard transmissions are permitted.
Must have stock style suspension and DOT tires.
2. Diesel Trucks: 2-wheel drive, automatic and standard transmissions are permitted.
Must have stock style suspension and DOT tires.
3. Gas Trucks: 4-wheel drive, automatic and standard transmissions are permitted. Must have stock style suspension and DOT tires.
4. Gas Trucks: 2-wheel drive, automatic and standard transmissions are permitted.
Must have stock style suspension and DOT tires.
5. Alerted Class: Anything Goes!

Rules:

1. Minor drivers must present a valid Driver's License to participate in this event.
2. All dirt racing will be conducted on a dirt surface. (i.e., pulling track)
3. Two side by side lanes will be marked with a white chalk line.
4. The track will be "worked" to ensure a safe and fair drag race.
5. Dirt drag racing is available to diesel and gas trucks, mud bog vehicles, and most other vehicles will be allowed to compete.
6. Vehicles will be inspected and it will be determined if you are allowed to run by the Tech Officials. Gas tanks must be secure and seatbelts must be worn.
7. Vehicles should be insured.
8. A current and valid photo Driver's License is required by all drivers. Any drivers below the age of 18 must have a notarized consent waiver form completed by a parent or guardian.
9. The use of any form of alcohol or substance is prohibited on the fairgrounds.

10. All vehicles planning to drag must register and pay all entry fees.
11. Starting of the drag race will be by a hand-operated tree lighting system.
12. Each vehicle must have a number on the front of the vehicle so the officials and announcer can clearly see who is racing.
13. Drivers must stay with their vehicle while their class is participating.
14. Any vehicle that touches the white line on the “out of bounds” marks will be disqualified.
15. After your second “jump start” you will be disqualified.
16. Winners will return to the staging area immediately to receive staging instructions for their next race.
17. No speeding or hot rodding after leaving the track or in the pit area. Vehicles operating in an unsafe manner can result in disqualification.
18. Motorsports are inherently dangerous. You should take part in this competition based on your own assessment of your abilities.
19. The promotor DOES NOT provide medical insurance coverage. We urge drivers not to compete in any motorsports without adequate personal medical insurance coverage. Spectators witnessing these events thereby assume all risks for any injuries or damages resulting there from.
