1. All products must have been made by the exhibitor. Premiums will not be paid for commercial products.
2. Complete baked goods must be brought to the fair. After judging, the fair may display only a portion of the product for the week.
3. Baked products to be judged on flavor, lightness, general appearance and crumb.
4. Pies are to be judged on texture of crust and flavor and consistency of filling.
5. **DISPLAY ON PAPER PLATES IN A RESEALABLE PLASIC BAG**
6. Each exhibitor may enter only one item per class. **For ages 8-Adult only**
7. **Classes 1 - 53 require a \$0.40 entry fee.  
Special Baking Contest requires a \$2.50 fee.**

1. Canned fruits and vegetables to be judged on quality, general appearance and container.
2. Use standard clear glass mason-type quart or pint jars for preserving and exhibiting all entries.
3. Use two piece self-sealing lids with metal bands for sealing all jars for exhibit. Metal bands must be left on entries.
4. Any entry not in a standard self-sealing jar with a sealed lid will not be judged and will be disqualified . Entries must be made by the exhibitor. **For ages 8-Adult only**
5. **A fee of \$0.40 for all single entries.  
A fee of \$0.60 for all display entries. Section 2 & 3**
6. Displays consist of 3 different varieties, attractively displayed.
