Class & Payout Guidelines

All classes will be pro-rated.

This means payouts adjust based on how many tractors actually hook in each class.

A minimum of 6 tractors must hook in a class for the full purse payout.

If a class has fewer than 6 tractors, the payout will be **pro-rated** based on the actual number of participants.

Purse percentage will be based on the number of participants in each class.

If fewer tractors enter, the payout scales accordingly; if the class fills up, the full purse applies.

SECTION 1 - ANTIQUE TRACTOR PULLS

OX HILL FAIR TRACTOR PULL RULES

All Classes are intended for agricultural production type tractors. No - homemade, experimental, industrial or prototype tractors are permitted.
Tractor years allowed in 4MPH and 10MPH, 1960 and Older
Open/Unlimited Classes is for any AGE tractor.

GENERAL RULES

One driver per tractor, per class.

1. **ENTRY** – A tractor may pull only once in each class. Pull promoters decide the number of classes each tractor may enter in excess of two classes.
2. **AGE** – Pullers under 16 must have a parent or guardian present at sign-up.
3. **DRIVER** – Drivers must remain seated at all times. No bouncing in the seat is permitted. Hands must stay on the steering wheel, hand brakes, hand clutch, or throttle during the pull. Do not attempt to start a tractor by pushing it off the scale. No riders are allowed on a moving tractor. Driver must be seated when starting the tractor. Tractors must not exceed 4 MPH off the track or in the pit area.
4. **ALCOHOL & BEHAVIOR** – No abuse or over-consumption of alcohol or drugs will be tolerated. No abusive or aggressive language or behavior will be tolerated on or off the track.
5. **BARRED** – Any tractor or puller found unsafe, unruly, illegal, or disrespectful of Fair rules may be disqualified.
6. **SIGNING IN** – You must be signed in and registered before a weight class starts. Registration ends when the class is called to line-up. No exceptions.
7. **WEIGHING IN** – Each tractor must weigh in and have hitch height checked before hooking to the sled. This is required for every class entered. Do not block or linger on the scales.

SAFETY & EQUIPMENT

8. **WHEELIE BARS** – Highly recommended for 4 MPH classes. Required for 10 MPH and OPEN. Minimum requirements: Max 10" above ground; extend 5" behind tire radius; pads 5" square minimum, spaced 20" apart; must support tractor and driver weight; officials may test strength.
9. **DRAWBAR / HITCH** – Hitch material 3/4"-1.25" thick. Hole 3" wide with 1" material or approved clevis/D-ring with 3.75" long hole. Top of hitch adjuster must not exceed axle/hub centerline. Hitch must be stationary and locked.
10. **DRAWBAR – 4 MPH CLASSES** – Max height 18".
11. **DRAWBAR – 10 MPH & OPEN** – Max height 20".
12. **DRAWBAR – HYDRAULIC** – No tampering with hydraulic control drawbar while pulling.

TRACTOR SAFETY & EQUIPMENT

13. **COVERS & EXHAUST** – All flywheels must be covered. JD 2-cylinder clutch housing must be covered. All fans, PTOs, and exposed moving parts must be shielded. All exhaust must be vertical.
14. **SEATS – 10 MPH & OPEN** – High-back seat (7"), fenders supporting driver weight, dead-man throttle, SFI blanket required in OPEN.
15. **KILL SWITCH** – Kill switch is required in all Open classes.
16. **ROLL CAGE** – A roll bar or roll cage is required in All Open classes.
17. **SEAT BELTS** – Seat belts are required when hooked to the sled in all Open classes.
18. **FIRE EXTINGUISHERS** – Recommended for 4 MPH; required for 10 MPH & OPEN; must be accessible and up to date.

WEIGHTS & BRACKETS

19. **WEIGHT** – Suitcase or custom weights allowed; must be secure.
20. **WEIGHT BRACKETS** – 4MPH and 10MPH Front weights may extend no farther than 11 ft from rear axle center. OPEN 13 ft from rear axle center. No weights behind rear tires.
21. **WEIGHT OR PART FALLING OFF** – Any part/weight falling off while hooked results in DQ. No measurement or refund.

TRACTOR SPECIFICATIONS

22. **CHASSIS – 4 MPH & 10 MPH** – Must maintain stock/factory wheelbase and component locations.
23. **ENGINE CONFIGURATION – OPEN CLASSES** – V8 engines are permitted in Open classes only. Any manufacture engine in any tractor so long as all other rules are met.
24. **TIRES – NOT ALLOWED** – No radials, duals, chains, studs, steel wheels, or non-ag tires
25. **TIRES – 4500lb–5500lb** – Max 15.5x38, no full cuts.
26. **TIRES – 6500lb–7500 lb** – Max 16.9x38, no full cuts.
27. **TIRES – 8500lb -9500lb** – Max 18.4x38, no full cuts.
28. **TIRES – 10 MPH & OPEN** – Max 18.4x38, any cut allowed.
29. **FUELS** – Gas, Diesel, or LP only. No nitrous oxide. Open-class tractors may use alcohol fuel. Any tractor running alcohol must be clearly marked on the tractor.
30. **DIESEL ENGINE – 4 MPH & 10 MPH** – Diesel-only tractors cannot be converted. Must be pre-1959 or matching series. Naturally aspirated; no turbos except factory.
31. **DIESEL ENGINE – OPEN CLASSES** – Turbo maximum size is 3in inlet x 3in outlet. Single turbo only. Water injections are allowed.

TRACTOR TRACK RULES

32. **SPEED LIMITS** – 4 MPH and 10 MPH. No shifting TAs. One beep after cone = DQ.
33. **SPEED – MARKERS & ATTEMPTS** – Passing the 50/75 ft marker voids distance. Two attempts allowed.
34. **OUT OF BOUNDS** – Any tractor or sled contact outside boundaries results in DQ.
35. **FULL PULL** – Full pull distance set by track crew and sled operator. Sled reading is final.
36. **RE-PULL** – If a class restarts, all registered tractors may re-pull. No new entries allowed.
