LIGHT TOUGH FARM TRACTOR PULL RULES & REGULATIONS

Northwest Pennsylvania Truck & Tractor Pulling Association Rules Apply

1. Weight Class: 8000lb.
2. No jumping to Farm Stock Classes.
3. All tractors must have stock appearing hood, grill, frame, and fenders in place. Factory Wheelbase must be retained. All tractors must have fenders.
4. Tires- Contest is open to farm tractors with rubber tires. No cut tires, no tire studs, or chains permitted. Four -wheel drive tractors are permitted if front wheels are disengaged. No dual wheels. All factory wheels must be in place. Maximum tire size of 18.4x38.
5. Engine - 3000 rpm limit on all tractors.
Diesel-360 cubic inch limit. Tractor must be stock agricultural block or factory replacement. No visual modifications (i.e. intake manifolds, water injection or modified injection lines, etc..) Must have factory manifolds.

6. Turbo - Must match make and model of tractor or may be no larger than a box 3LM 466. The compressor housing will have a maximum of 2.3" inside diameter (I.D.) of intake and 2.0" outside diameter outlet. The exhaust housing will be no larger than 360 with a maximum outlet of 2.8" I.D.
 - Gas tractor must be stock agricultural block or factory replacement. Open cubic inch. No V-8 engines. Naturally aspirated with single up-draft carburetor. Gas engines with 360 CI or less can run a turbo no larger than a box 3LM 466.
 - Injection Pump (OEM injection pump) must burn fuel as factory equipped. Must be a rotary style pump. No P-pumps or A-pumps permitted, unless factory installed. Contestant must provide SOLID specifications on tractor entered.
 - Heads must be OEM cast iron heads. No aluminum heads permitted.
 - 5.9 Cummins engines considered to be factory replacement for Oliver and/or White Tractors. Must be 12-valve head and must have rotary style pumps, no A or P pumps.
 - 5.9 Cummins engines can be installed and entered in other makes as long as a factory adapter plate and factory bellhousing is in place. Must be 12-valve head rotary style pumps, no A or P pumps.
 - All 5.9 Cummins must have a safety blanket 360 degrees around bellhousing.
7. Hydraulic systems and PTO are not required.
8. All tractors must be equipped with both rear brakes working. Use of torque converters, automatic shift, etc. is permitted. No industrial tractors or slipper clutches allowed.
9. No foot cross over and no hand control of foot brakes permitted.
10. Drawbar: Minimum drawbar length is 18" from the center of rear axle to point of hook up. Drawbar must be stationary in all directions. Maximum height is 20" from top of hitching device parallel to the ground. Any vertical clevis will be measured to center of loop. Hitch hole must be at least 3 1/2" diameter and have at least 1" cross section at the hook point. No bracing above center of rear axle except for complete factory set-up. If above center it must be cradled.
11. Weight: All weights must be secured to the tractor. No weight may extend more than 24" beyond the forward most point of hood or front tires. No weights to extend past the rear of the rear tire. No weights permitted on seat or deck. Any weights or external parts lost while hooked to the sled will be cause for disqualification of the pull. No refunds will be given.
12. Safety Equipment Required: Wheelie bars must be capable of supporting tractor when the tractor is weighted to 8000#. Wheelie bars must be independent of the pulling hitch. Air shut off device on intake of diesel engines, connected to the pulling sled. Ignition kill switch on spark ignited engines, connected to the pulling sled. Clutch safety blankets, Roll over protection. (ROPS) All tractor's flywheels to be steel construction, tractor owner will be required to sign a document that stated a steel flywheel is installed. All competitors must wear a DOT approved helmet. Engine shields are required, including fans and turbochargers.

OPEN TOUGH FARM TRACTOR PULL RULES & REGULATIONS

Weight Class: 10,500lb.

1. AGE - Minimum age 18. Ages 16-17 years permitted with a signed and notarized parental/guardian permission,
2. APPEARANCE & ENGINE - Tractor must be stock in appearance for make and model. Hoods, grills, fenders, and frame must remain stock. Tractor must use a stock block or factory replacement. Diesel fuel only.
3. CLOTHING - Driver must wear leather shoes and long pants.
4. DRAWBAR - Must be stationary.
 - Max height: 20"
 - Min distance: 18" from center of rear axle to hitch point
 - Clevis not permitted
5. DRIVER POSITION - Driver must remain seated with at least one hand on the wheel at all times. Driver may not leave the seat while the tractor is running.
6. ENTRY FEE - \$25.00
EXHAUST - Must discharge vertically.
 - Two Grade 5 (3/8") cross bolts required
 - Bolts must be 90° apart
 - Bolts must be within 1" of each other
 - Bolts must be placed as close to turbo as possible
7. FRONT END - Wide front end required.
8. FUEL SYSTEM - No pressurized fuel tanks permitted.
9. HELMET - Motorsport rated helmet required (Snell 80 or higher).
10. HITCHING DEVICE - Steel hitch only.
 - Thickness: 1" min to 1.5" max
 - Opening: 3.5" diameter
 - Pulling point: No more than 1.5" from back edge of device
11. LOSS OF PARTS - Any loss of weights, fluids, or tractor parts during pull = DQ. Tarp straps not allowed anywhere on tractor.
12. MANIFOLDS - OEM stock intake and exhaust manifolds required for that series. Engine alterations allowed only for turbo mounting.
13. RIDERS - Only one person permitted on tractor at any time.

OPEN TOUGH FARM TRACTOR PULL RULES & REGULATIONS

14. **SAFETY EQUIPMENT** - Note: A true farm stock tractor operating at no more than 10% over OEM RPM is exempt.
 - Steel engine side shields required
 - Approved transmission/clutch blanket required
 - Engine fans must have factory shroud or 1/16" steel shroud
 - Working kill switch or air shutoff required
 - 2.5 lb. dry chemical fire extinguisher accessible to driver
15. **TIRES** - Max tire size 20.8". Cut tires permitted.
16. **TURBOCHARGER** - Single turbo only. No size restriction.
17. **TURBO COOLING** - Water injection for turbo cooling permitted. No accelerants, oxygen extenders, or similar additives allowed.
18. **WEIGHTS** -
 - Front weights may not extend more than 13 ft from center of rear axle
 - Rear weights may not extend more than 6" past rear tires
 - Rear weights must not interfere with hooking or unhooking
19. **WHEELIE BARS** - Must support the weight of the tractor.
